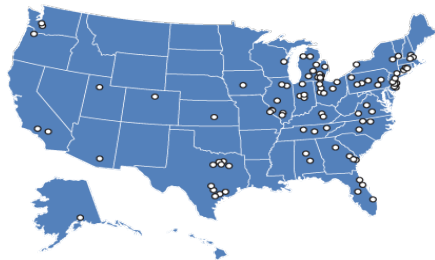

Medinotes Passwords

MediNotes

Through security manger in Medinotes (a module that is included in all 5.2 versions!) allows you to work with your Medinotes passwords! Here, you can ensure that your Medinotes remains safe and secure:

- Reset passwords
- Enforce complex passwords
- Set password expirations
- Lock accounts for multiple login failures



To access security Manager, go to Start - Programs - Medinotes - Modules - Security Manager

If you are logging in for the first time, your temporary password will be medi. You will then be prompted to create a password. When you log into security manger, go to File - Security Options and you can enforce complex passwords, set password expirations and lock accounts for multiple login failures.

To reset a password for a user, click on users (found on the left hand tree) and double click users name on the right side of the tree. Simply click the Reset Password File and the users password will be reset to medi. Once they log in with the password "medi" they will be prompted to create new password.

Scanner not working? Unable to get your EOB's done without it?

Here are a few things to check:

Cables - Check the cables at both ends. Check the end that's plugged into the scanner, and then check the end that plugs into your PC. Also check the power cord -are they all in tight? If not, push them in tight and try scanning again.



Scanner power - "Is this thing on?" Some of the scan shell type scanners don't have a power indicator light on them. Try pressing the power button once (if the scanner is off, this will power it on). Try scanning again. If the scanner doesn't react, press the power button again (if the first button push turned the scanner off, this will turn it back on).

Are you using RemoteScan? Most of the time, if RemoteScan is in use and is the reason for your scanning issues, you will receive an error message that reads "No RemoteScan device selected". If you are, check the RemoteScan Scan Server (the PC with the scanner plugged directly into it). There should be an icon in the System Tray (down near the clock) that looks like a flatbed scanner with a line underneath it. Right click this icon, and go to Choose TWAIN Scan Driver. Choose your scanner from this menu. Try scanning again.
